The loss/gain is only for TOPS members. KOPS gets a mark for being in the black. At the end of August give the forms to your weight recorder. Have her/him put the first weight in June and last in August then have her/him mail them to either myself or if you have an area captain mail them to her. She or I have to have them by the 10th of September to qualify. I hope this clears up the confusion. Any more questions please let me or your area captain know.

I am asking you as a leader to every month to ask your members if they have received their renewal form. If they have, tell them to bring them to the meeting right away. They do not need to pay them right away but at least they are available when it gets closer and they do not get lost. Have the treasurer keep them or put them in a place that they will be seen often. You need to have them to me at least 1 month ahead of the due date so that your membership does not get interrupted. I process memberships weekly but by the time I process, mail them and headquarter receive and do their paperwork it takes a lot of time. Another question to your members is "Are you receiving your magazine?" We need to do whatever is possible to help our members and save memberships. Thanks to all you do!!!

If you have members who have not been coming or their membership has lapsed, why doesn't your chapter send out a "Thinking of you" card? You never know you might get them to come back.

Keep up the good work and get out and spread the word about TOPS. If there is a health fair that is available let me know so we can get TOPS name out there to help others.
